Anti-Ragging Committee Report:

The Anti-Ragging Committee and the Anti-ragging squad team were formed on 30/July /2018 as per VTU circular No. VTU/Aca/Academic-cir/2012-2103/1747 dated 6/June 2012.

As per the discussion in the Anti-ragging committee meeting, as followed during the previous academic years, at the beginning of the academic year, the department heads have visited the classes of all senior students of their respective departments and created awareness about the legal consequences of ragging. The Anti – Ragging posters were displayed in places such as Classrooms, Food court, Notice boards, and Hostels. The posters of the Anti–Ragging Committee and Anti–Ragging squad team which constituted for the academic year 2018 – 19 were also displayed along with the contact details of the members, in all prominent places.

As per the discussion, Anti-ragging squad teams were formed to help newly joined students at places like Hostels, Food court, and Parking areas. To record the observations made by the teams, the Log registers have been maintained at all prominent places such as Food court, Hostels, College buses, etc. The Faculty members have visited these places as per the specified schedule and have recorded their observations (if any) in the respected registers. The visiting time and frequency of visits by the vigilance teams are shown in the below table.
