1 Guest Lecture on Breast Cancer Awareness

A guest lecture on Breast Cancer awareness was organized on 15th September 2015 for all the female students and faculty of MITE in association with AHC MITE. The resource person Dr. Sandhya I is working as an Assistant Professor in the Dept. of Pathology at A. J. Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Mangalore. The resource person highlighted in her lecture that cancer is caused due to the alteration in genes and then, it becomes self-regulatory when the cells within the body become uncontrollable and also, she advised that it is curable, if diagnosed early. She emphasized on the various treatments available for breast cancer such as Lumpectomy, Mastectomy, Reconstruction, Radiation Therapy, Chemotherapy, and Hormonal Therapy.
