Report on "Student Guidance & Mentoring"

Student guidance and mentoring is a session conducted with an objective to enhance basic mentoring skills to the faculty. It could enable them to identify the underlying problems of students, use the right technique to analyse and tackle day-to-day issues faced in their lives. This will kindle the potential among faculty members to ignite hope, kindle imagination and inspire a deep love of learning.

Dr. Suphala Kotian, founder of Nirel Charitable Trust is a counsellor and has expertise in geriatric mental health. The speaker introduced mentoring, its profound meaning, the need and its relevance. Mentoring should be like a talk to a mind - thoughts emanating from the minds of a mentor enlightening a student's mind.

The counsellor outlined the qualities a mentor is required to possess. The key skill for a mentor; even before actual counselling starts, is the art of active listening. Dr. Suphala pointed out the importance of observation skills and urged a mentor to talk positively and be an optimist. She further added that it is essential to inculcate family values – the values of life in a mentee. It is equally important to know the family background of a student. The speaker elucidated the role of education in the current scenario. "Build a strategy for the child, individualize it and build a goal-only then the plant will transform into a strong, sturdy and beautiful tree," said Dr. Suphala. She also stressed the point that students have to be taught to have internal control. She added, "Counselling is nothing but allowing a student to ventilate so that students arrive at the right decision after evaluating various alternatives. She also highlighted that confidentiality between a mentor and mentee is very important. The student will lose his trust if the mentor discusses the issues of the mentee with his/her colleagues. Dr. Suphala concluded the session with a great message "Be to Yourself, Be a role model and give quality time to your students"

After the closure of the session, three students having serious problems from different departments were presented to her for counselling. She conducted face-to-face counselling sessions for them to help them to realize the root cause of their problems. The students were allowed to vent



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out their problems and they were then offered help to find solutions to overcome their issues. The respective mentors were also advised on ways to extend support, guidance and encouragement to their mentees.

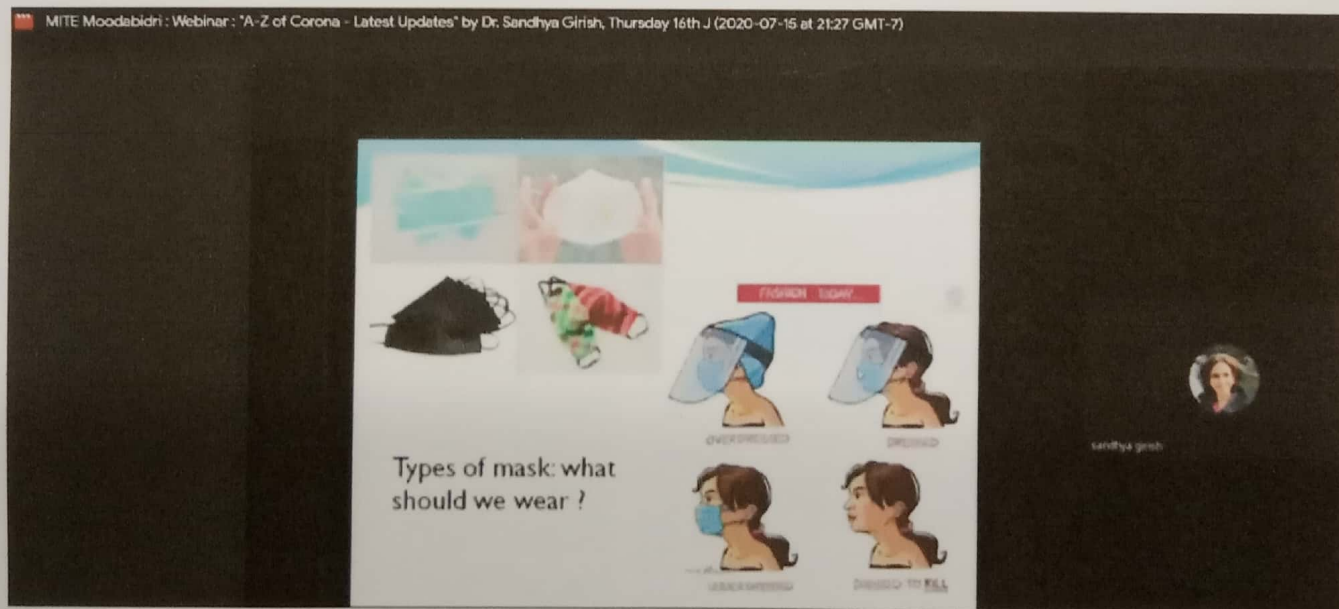
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
Report on “A-Z of Corona - Latest Updates”



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
