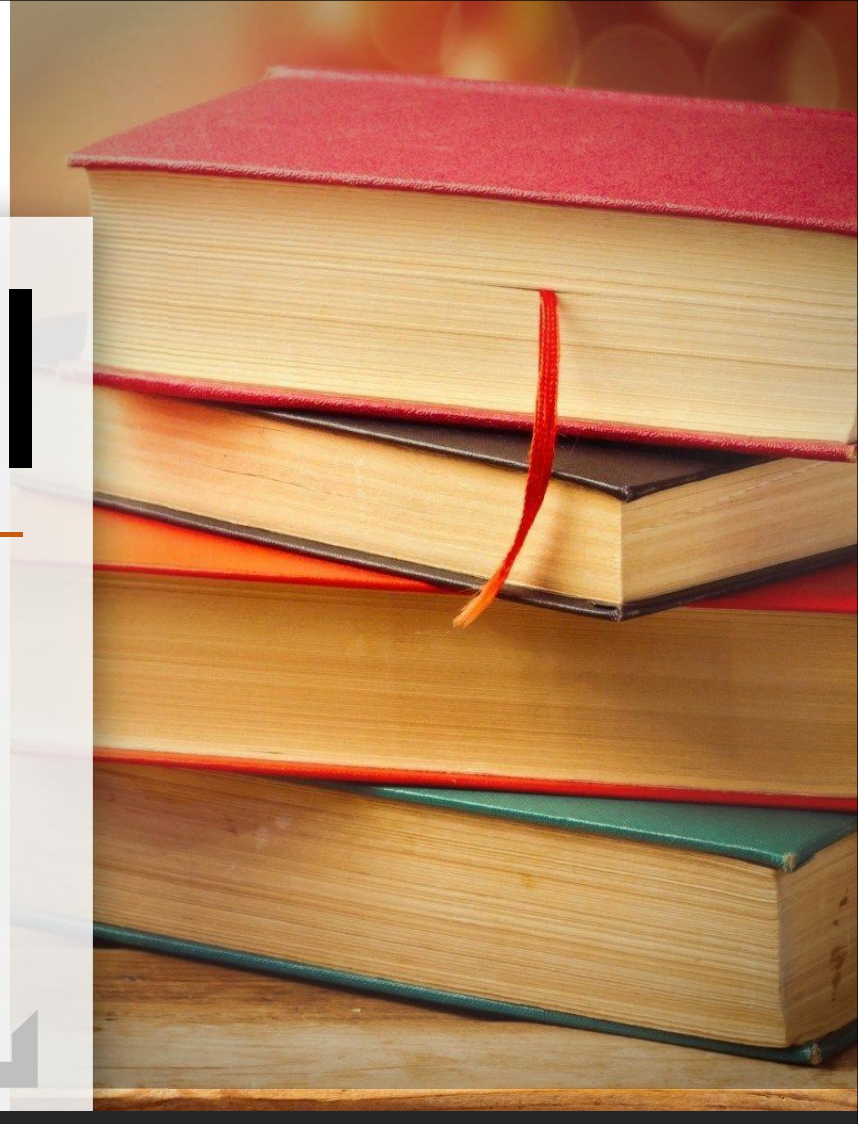

LETTER WRITING



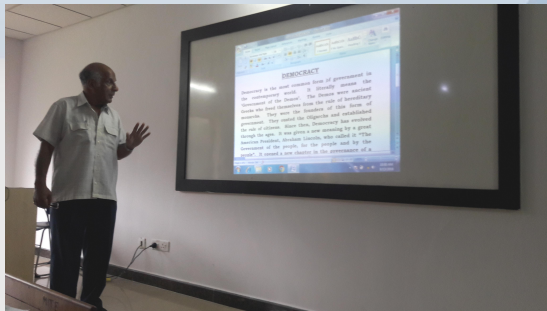
