Approval of Library requirements of Books, Special Books/Rare Books, Journals & Other materials:

The Committee reviewed the Book requirements received by all the departments, and approved the same for procurement. The Librarian was assigned the responsibility to call for Competitive quotations and prepare comparative statements from different publishers and place the order based on better offers.

Better utilization of the resources available in the library

Library Committee was informed to create awareness to the students about the books, journals, magazines and online journals. Also, they were informed to create awareness about the availability of the previous year's University question papers. The committee decided to arrange workshops and webinars about usage of e resources and Turnitin Software. Committee Members should also discuss with students for any issues related to the Library and bring it to the notice of the Librarian for improvement.

Meeting II

The Second meeting of the Library Advisory Committee for the Academic year 2020-21 was held on 06/11/2020 at 12:30 pm, Ground floor Library Discussion Room.

Review of purchase details.

The library advisory committee revived the books purchased for the semester. The New books are given accession numbers and details fed into library database, which is made available for circulation for the users.

Renewing the membership of VTU Consortium towards the subscription of e –Resources.

The Committee had a discussion on renewal of VTU Consortium membership, e-Resources Subscription and conducting awareness program on remote access &webinars. It was decided to continue the Membership and the Librarian was informed to process the same immediately. Also, decision was taken on the purchase of required books, based on the requirements received from different Departments. The Librarian was assigned the responsibility to call for Competitive quotations and prepare comparative statements from different publishers and place the order based on better offers.

The Institute already being a member of National Digital Library (NDL) since 2017 had initiated the process required to apply for the NDLI Club. The Committee was informed that the data required for the same had been submitted and the Institute Membership for NDLI Club has been approved from the current academic year 2020-21.

Better utilization of Budget

During the Academic year 2020-21, the Budget allocated for Library was 25 Lakhs of which Rs.21,89,092.00 was utilized for the purchase of Books, subscription to VTU Consortium e Resources .And Rs. 27,318.00 for Newspapers and Magazines.

WEB ACCESS: REMOTE ACCESS

MITE Library has provided remote access to the resources wherein users can access literature from any location any time of the day. User credentials were provided to the users across the Institute to utilize this facility. Awareness training programs were also conducted for the ease of users on web access which was well appreciated. During the time of COVID pandemic, our e-access system was of immense help to the institute and all the users, and it was further strengthened with multiple webinars.

Dr. Suphala Kotian brief about the challenges faced by teachers, students and parents owing to the online pedagogy adopted during the ongoing pandemic of COVID-19.
