Symptoms include having less energy and drive to do things, less interest in work, loss of recent memory, mild coordination problem, mood swings that involve depression or a general lack of interest.

Preventive measures are regular exercise, social engagement, healthy diet, mental stimulation, quality sleep, stress management.


