VISIT TO VIJETHA SPECIAL SCHOOL

15.08.2016

Independence Day is a very special occasion for everyone at MITE for it not only gives an opportunity to pay our respects to the National flag but it also gives us a chance to engage in some compassionate work for the society. It is the annual routine at MITE that after the flag hoisting ceremony volunteers from Red Cross and NSS pay a visit to a special school/orphanage of an oldage home to engage themselves in some service activity.

Accordingly, on the eve of 15th August, 2016, Subsequent to the formal Independence Day ceremony, a team of MITE representatives visited Vijetha Special School, Karkala to celebrate the day with special children.

Vijetha special school, run by Sri Guru Raghavendra Trust, houses about 40 children who are specially-abled. The school takes care of these children and their educational needs. Apart from school education, they are also taught

special skills to make handicrafts which are sold in the market. Dr. Kanti Harish, the Managing Trustee, was a teacher earlier who resigned from her service and started his school. She is the main spirit behind this school.

Groceries, utensils, bed sheets. Uniform materials worth Rs.71,800 and Rs 35,000 in cash was donated to the inmates of the school by the MITE fraternity.

These are moments of great pride and satisfaction to the Red Cross members for having done something for the less endowed amongst us. Students develop a sense of duty and service motive towards society which goes a long way in shaping up one's personality for future life.
