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## WOMEN ENTREPRENEURSHIP SUMMIT – 2018

### Marching Ahead: The Power Within

**November 02, 2018 to November 03, 2018**

MITE, Moodbidri organized its mega event of the year, “Women’s entrepreneurship summit 2018” under the leadership of Department of Business Administration and NAIN Incubation Center on 2nd and 3rd November 2018 which had 13 successful Women entrepreneurs under one roof. The event was based on the theme - ‘Marching ahead- the power within’. The event was inaugurated at 10 in the morning by Ms. Sarita Santhosh chief guest, founder of Sunshine travels & holidays. Dr. G. L Eshwara Prasad, Principal, Prof. Jayadeva Prasad M, HOD-MBA, Ms. Jaya Shetty, Program coordinator. Ms. Sarita Santhosh addressed the gathering.

She said, “This summit has significance for future managers and is not just meant for women but also men as entrepreneurship is not an easy art for anyone to take as a profession ”.

### Panel Discussion 1: Women Entrepreneurship – Role and challenges





Ms. Sarita Santhosh, Ms. RituChabriaSah (Founder Partner of Vanassara Food Pvt. Ltd.), Ms. Supriya R Kamath (Managing Partner at UttamAgro Industries), Ms. Maithri Chandrashekar (Centre head at Eurokidz Manipal) and Ms. Harsha Kamath (Managing Partner at L G Industries) were the speakers. All the speakers predominantly spoke about their life and business.

Sarita said, “To be a leader, you need to be an exemplary human being. When you are an entrepreneur you become an inspirational instance to your team, clients, customers. Every step you take should reflect this thought. For women marriage or any other situational change should not be a restriction. Take things positively, understand your ecosystem and women also have the in-born characteristics of meticulous, sincere and empathy, therefore women can be equally competent as men”.

Ms. Supriya Kamath said, “Gender discrimination, patriarchal society has all quite diminished and women are treated equally though cultural reconstruction is required for uplifting of women’s status. People discouraged me but success brought changes in the ecosystem henceforth urge to bring changes and be courageous to take risks ”.

Ms. Maithri said, “Women start realizing the importance of leadership when they lose their identity within four walls and engaged in family life . To be identified come out of your comfort zone and start living in the situations that ecosystem creates and tackle the challenges of the society then. Overcome the notions that society creates for women, raising capital is definitely a difficult task and comparatively more difficult for women, there will be many other obstacles also therefore build a strong team ”.

Ms. Harsha said ,” An entrepreneur should never expect anything, its always different situations and entrepreneurship is about overcoming those situations. Entrepreneur’s life is not explanatory, it is self discovery”.

## Panel Discussion 2: Women Entrepreneurship – My journey



Speakers were Ms.Poornima Prajwal Shetty (Co-founder of LOL Studios), Ms. Shwetha (Director of Anirvedha Resource Centre), Ms. Shipra Rai (Managing partner at Spindrift & Thyme restaurant) and Ms, Komal S Prabhu (Chief operating officer at Maharaja Restaurant). Ms. Poornima said, “Business competition is always your friend who makes you understand what your loss is. Research before you start up, it is crucial.”

Ms. Shwetha is not into business but service sector, she said,” you should follow your passion and prepared to take any risk for the passion, I being a psychologist faced many challenges strongly as I believed in my goal and therefore I could be a successful entrepreneur and serve the society”. Ms. Shipra said, “Women must be courageous enough to take dreams into action , business is not just being about master but also a person who has vision about consumers perception. As an entrepreneur the critical thing is, you trusting your instincts. Working in corporate is slow motion whereas entrepreneurship is fast track. Facing everyday is like fire fighting.”

Ms, Komal said “Everybody is rooted with their own strength we have to just look for it. I never thought my life was difficult because then it would be. From a social family I was married into a

conservative family and spent a few years of marriage in the kitchen. This made me bring my strength out. Entrepreneurship is difficult but you can create a world for yourself”.

### **Panel Discussion 3: Women Entrepreneurship – Beginner’s Guide.**



Speakers were Ms. Lakshmi M Rao (Managing Partner at Manjunath Rubber), Ms. Christabel D’Souza (Business Manager at Flora travels), Ms. Mariam Mohiudeen (Founder of Baker’s Treat from Mariam’s Kitchen) and Ms. SulajKini (Managing Partner at Bell Paints).

Ms. Lakshmi said, “I took up this business after my husband’s death and initially no one respected me. Handling business is all about taking risks. At first I was not ready to do that and my profit margin went on shrinking. My team of managers helped me a lot. Now we are successful and we are going to diversify our set-up.”

Ms. Christabel said, “My father started this business and tourism has also been my passion ever since. I learnt my work culture from my dad. You won’t face disappointments when expect negatives and to happen. I initially ventured the field by working under others and then took up my father’s company wherein experience taught me to be confident. One should be able to run the business without anyone that is entrepreneurship.”





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Ms. Mariam said “Thinking creatively and according to the preferences of people will help in developing the relationships, entrepreneurship does not depend on size of the organization , creativity and innovation is significant”.

Ms. Sulaj said, “Discipline, Punctuality and Knowledge are the keys to success to an entrepreneur. To be a successful entrepreneur dedicate yourself to the commitments. Hard work can only help in attainment of goals.”

Mr. DamodarPuthiya, CEO and Co-founder of Mobinius spoke about his journey from being a young graduate to a successful Entrepreneur. He urged students to have their objectives clear because that would always be the driving forces to succeed. Mr. Damodar stressed on the fact that to be an entrepreneur one has to be determined and ready to beat the odds.

His memories rolled back to the struggling days in Bangalore after graduation. Holding ourselves composed and letting not the surroundings dictate terms to us is the key to excel he said. The recipient of the **CII Southern Region Emerging Entrepreneur Award 2017**, Mr. Damodar said that an entrepreneur predominantly would be put through the wringer but it is pivotal to take the



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right decisions and importantly make their decisions right. Everyday poses a new challenge, one need to unlearn, learn and work towards their vision hesaid.



On being asked about the biggest challenge he had in his journey, Mr.Damodar said, building the right team, people with the same vigor and partners with unflinching faith in the business plan was always the greatest ordeal. Mr. Damodar who is also awarded **The Young Entrepreneur for Business Excellence by Indian Achievers Forum in 2016**, was posed with questions ranging from business, marketing, life as an entrepreneur, challenges, technology. While addressing query on marketing, he said when technology finds solution to problems of customers the product is bound to succeed. Substantiating this he cited how Uber/Ola has been successful in driving customers from all genre both young and old to use its services. Mr.Damodar asked one to have unflinching faith in oneself, not to deter and be dissuaded.


