#### **Anti-Ragging Committee Report:**

The Anti – Ragging Committee and the Anti – Ragging Squad team have been constituted for the academic year 2020-21, as per the guidelines issued by AICTE on 05/10/2020 to ensure '**NO RAGGING**' in the campus.

The Anti – Ragging posters were displayed in prominent places such as Classrooms, Food court, Notice boards, and Hostels. The posters of the Anti – Ragging Committee and Anti – Ragging squad team constituted for the academic year 2020 – 21 were also displayed in all prominent places along with the contact details of all the members of the committee.

At the beginning of the academic year, as per our regular practice the heads of all departments visited the classes of all senior students of their respective departments and created awareness about the legal consequences of ragging and informed them not to involve in any such bad practices.

In order to create a conducive academic atmosphere for newly joined students both in college and hostel premises, separate vigilance teams were also formed apart from Anti-Ragging Squad team. These vigilance teams have visited the Food court in both Tea break and Lunch break, parking area, both boys hostel and girls hostel, as per the specified schedule (Shown in the below table). The vigilance teams have recorded their observations in the log registers kept at these places. A separate 'early mess' arrangements were made for the first-year students by separating their lunch break time from seniors. To avoid any incidents of ragging in hostel first-year students and senior students are accommodated in separate blocks.

The faculties, who travel in the college bus daily, were informed to monitor the activities of the senior students in the bus and record the observations in the log register kept in buses. First-year students were seated in front seats, faculties in the middle and senior students were seated after faculties, thereby creating fearless travel for first-year students.

All the Anti-ragging squad members were involved effectively in providing safety and comfort to the newly joined students. The teams visiting the hostel interacted with first-year students individually and helped them to solve their academic or even personal problems (if any).

The residential wardens of both boys hostel and girls hostel monitored the students regularly in the mess during the breakfast, lunch, and dinner time there by ensuring the comfort zone for the first-year students in the hostel mess.

MITE campus is ragging free, still all these measures have been taken to create a homely and friendly atmosphere for the first-year students to pursue their studies. All of this was possible only because of the whole-hearted support from students and staffs. Hence no ragging is reported in the campus in the academic year 2020-21.

- 6. The committee Chairman informed all the members of the committee to continue the practice of maintaining log registers at all prominent places such as food courts, hostels, and college buses so that the Anti Ragging squad team can record the observations made by them.
- 7. As per our regular practice, it is decided to form a team of faculty members to regularly monitor newly joined students at places like Hostels, Food court and Parking area as per the specified schedule.
