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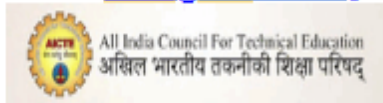

The National education policy 2020, has highlighted an interdisciplinary approach to improve the skills and job prospects of students and Higher education institutions are recommended to integrate vocational education and training to prepare learners for future jobs in this approach.
