Teachers Day- 5th September 2022

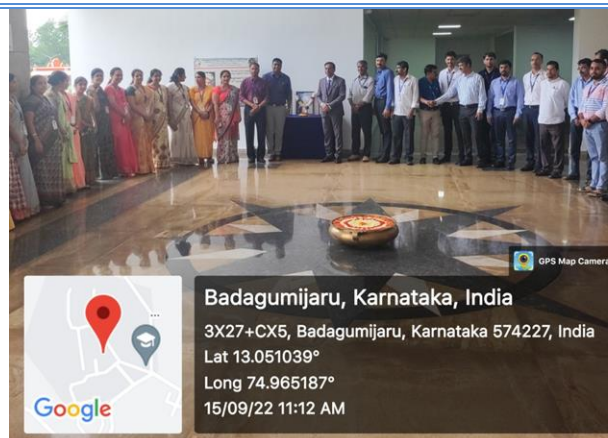
