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BUDGET & EXPENDITURES

The budget allocated for the library during the academic year 2023-24 was ₹30 Lakhs, which was utilized for the procurement of books, subscription to national journals, technical magazines, and payment for the VTU Consortium e-resources. The total expenditure amounted to ₹48,19,888.00. Additionally, the cost for newspaper and magazine subscriptions was ₹47,849.00.

Further expenses were incurred due to revisions in the scheme and syllabus, both in the Autonomous curriculum and VTU. In response to our requisition, the Parent Body provided the necessary funds to cover these additional costs.

Rs.47,849.00 for Newspapers and magazines. Which exceeded the allotted budget and this excess amount was paid by our management.

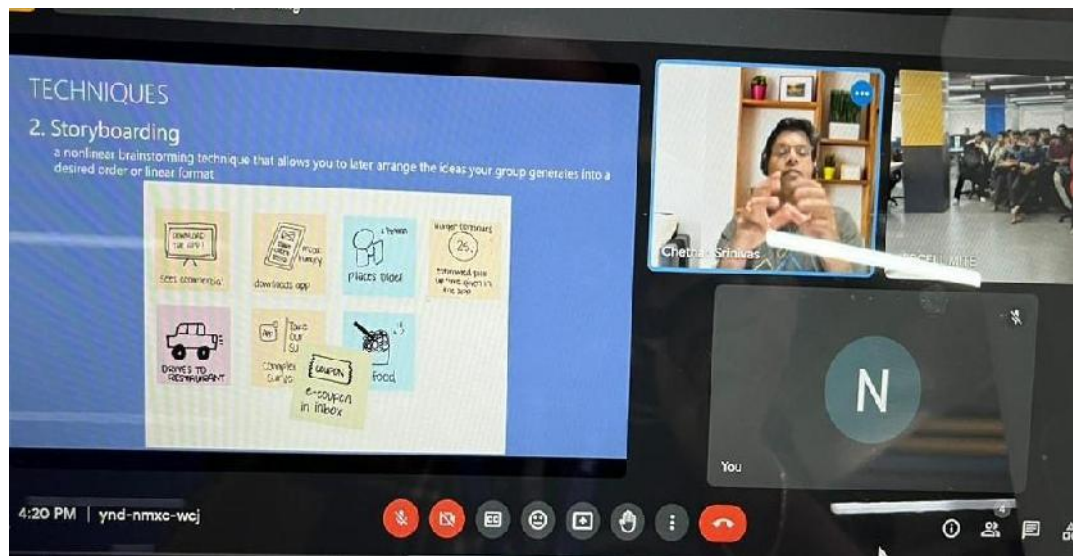
