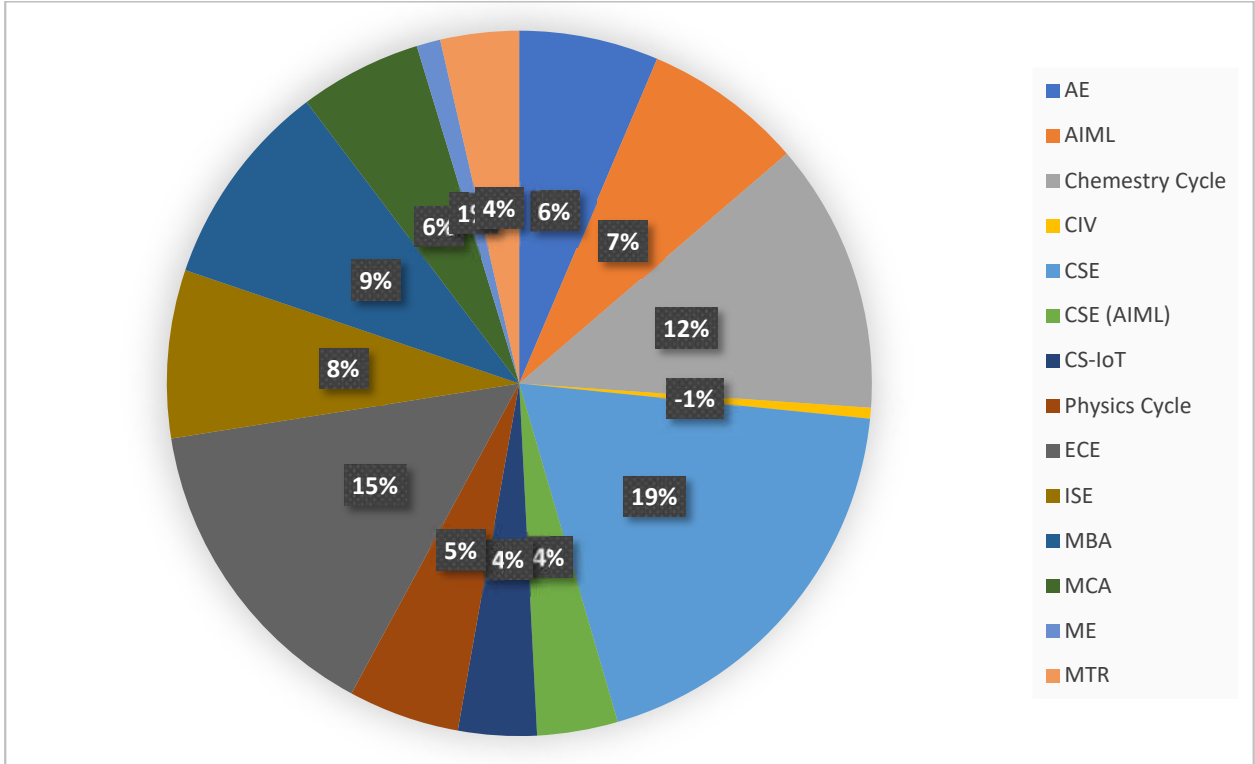


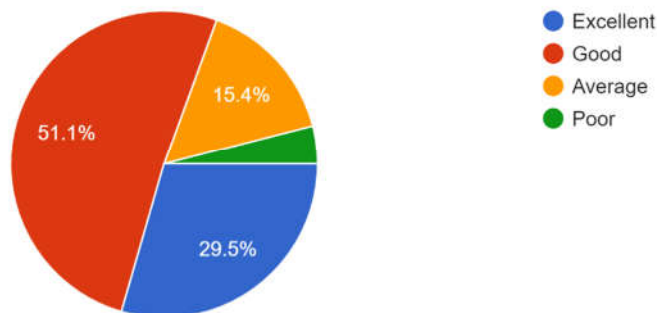

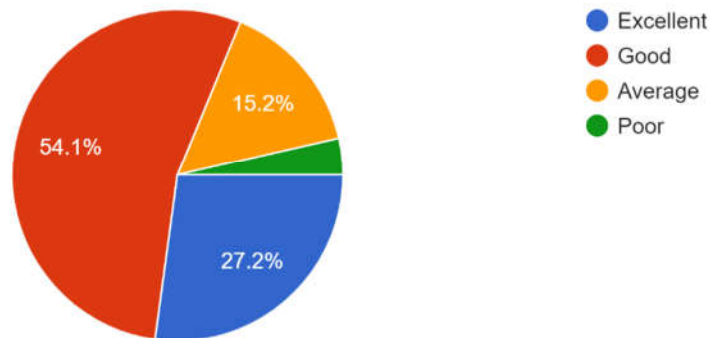
1. How would you rate the ambiance of your classroom, taking into consideration factors such as lighting, seating arrangement, quality of overall atmosphere provided?

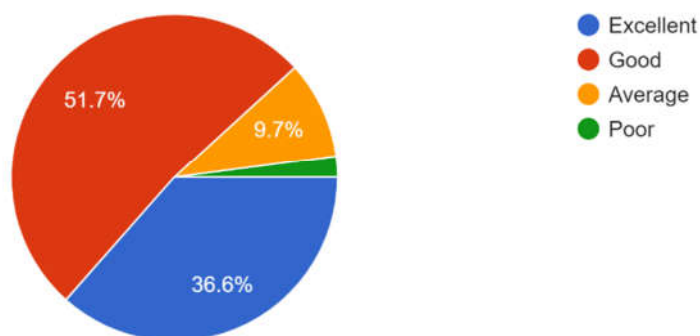
2. Rate the Department Laboratories in terms of ambiance , functioning of the equipment, organization of the equipment, support provided by the Laboratory Instructors etc.

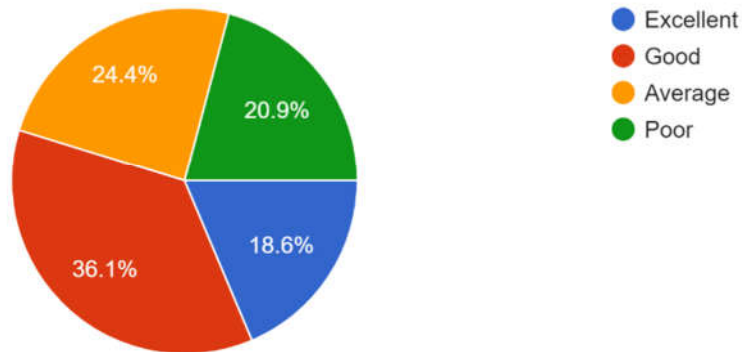

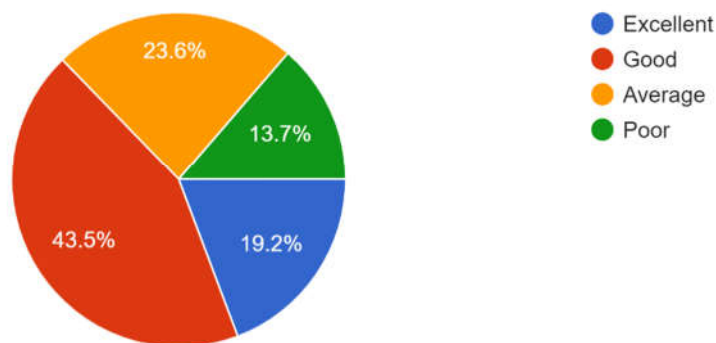
4. How would you rate the availability of the internet facility, considering the factors such as stability, speed, reliability, and coverage within the designated area.

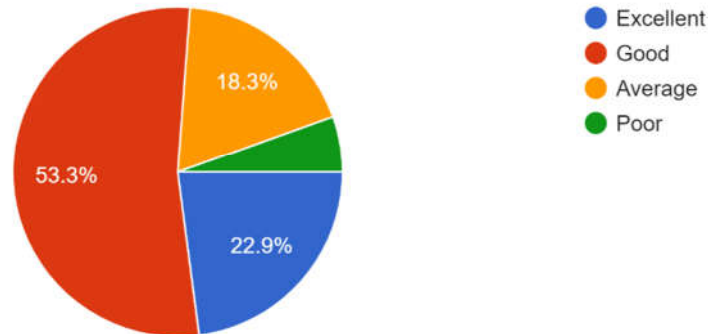

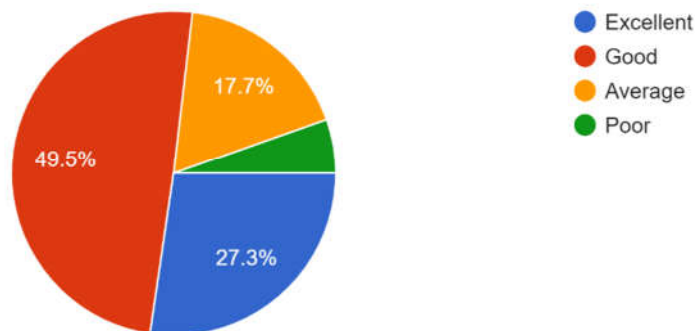
6. Rate the medical facility provided in the campus, based on the availability and accessibility of medical services.

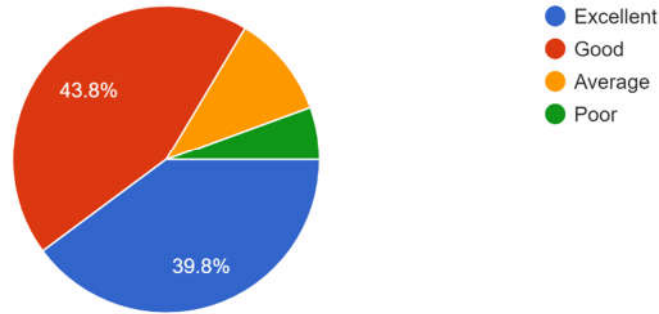
7. Rate the drinking water facility available on campus considering additional features or amenities related to the drinking water facility, such as water filters/coolers and areas for refilling water bottles.

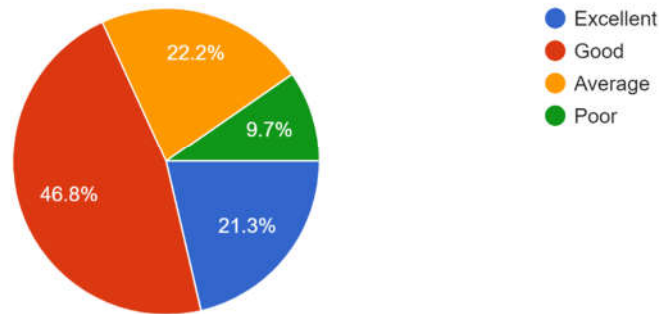

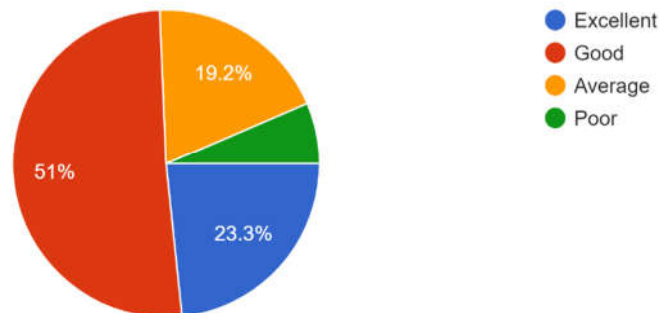

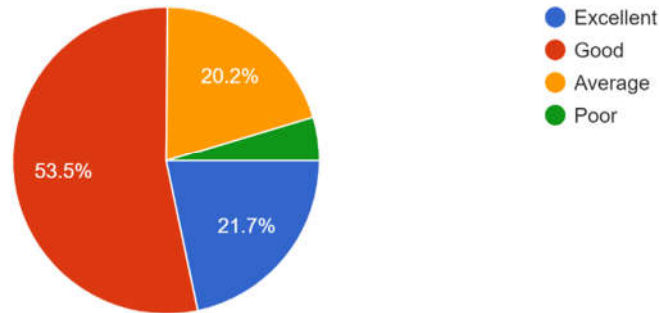

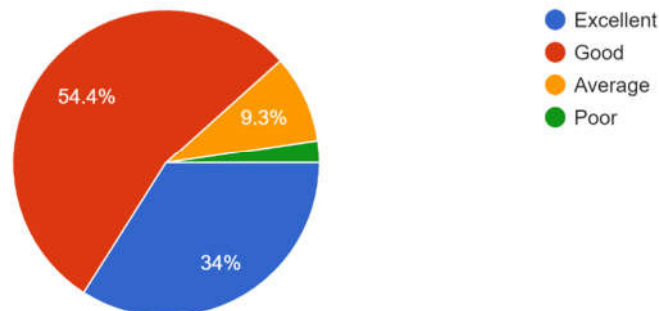

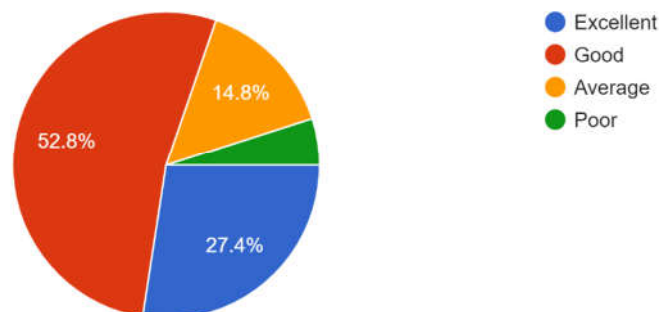
12. Rate the overall safety and security measures in place, including the presence of security personnel, surveillance systems, and access control protocols.

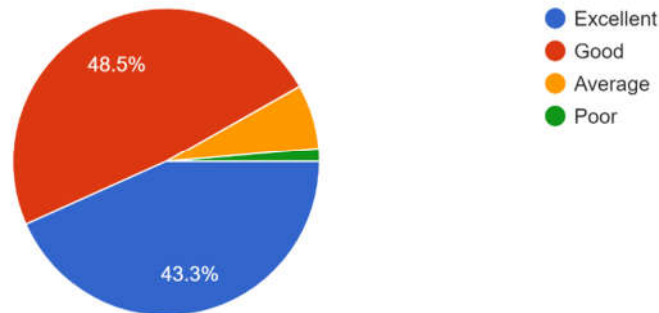
13. Rate the transportation facility provided by the college (If Applicable).

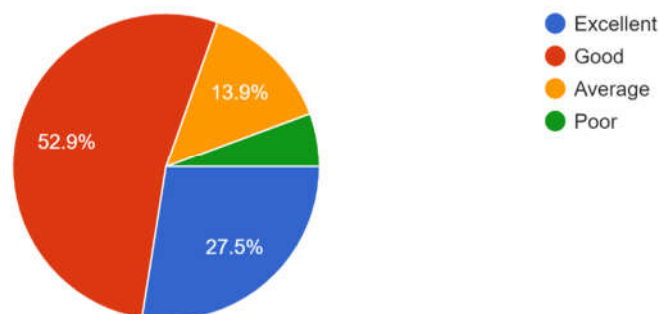

Major Observation

During the 2023-24 academic year, we conducted a survey to assess student satisfaction on various support facilities. This feedback was collected via Google Forms on May 27, 2024, with an impressive response from 2,588 students. After carefully analysing the survey results and comments, we identified a strong demand for improvements in several key areas, including laboratory resources, CCTV in the girls' hostel corridors, and internet facility. These insights provide a clear path for enhancing our facilities to better meet the needs and expectations of our student community.

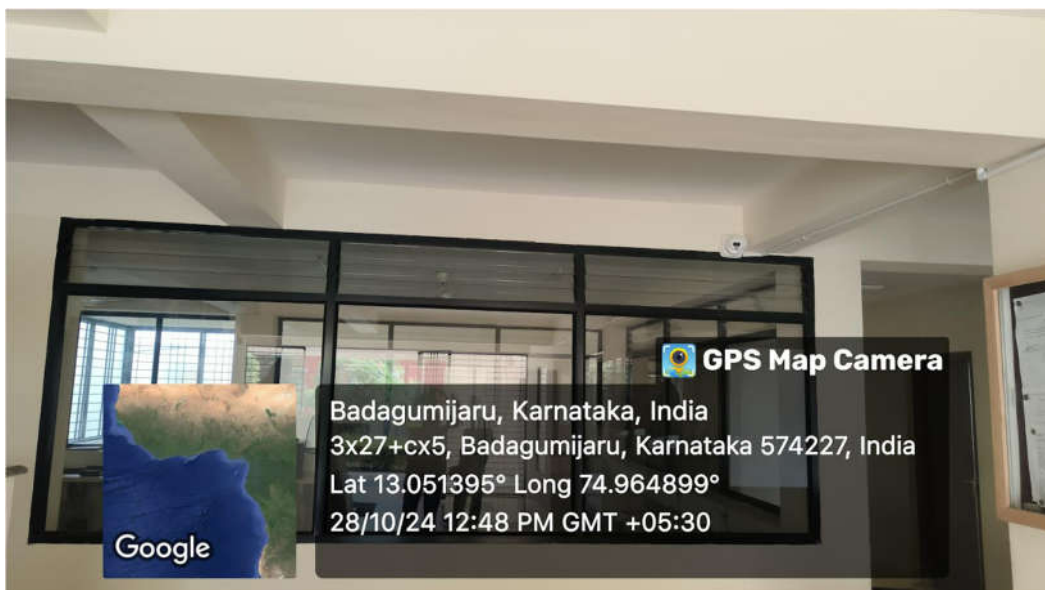
Action Taken

1.Laboratory Resources

A total of 246 desktop computers with the latest configuration—12th generation i5 processors, 16GB of RAM, and 512GB SSD storage—were procured to establish new labs/ upgrade of existing laboratory systems.

2.CCTV Installed in the Corridors of the Girls Hostel

In response to numerous student requests, CCTV cameras have been installed in the corridors of the girls' hostel.



CCTV installed in the Entrance of Girls hostel Block-1



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

3. Internet

In response to current demands, the internet connection speed has been upgraded to 1Gbps, significantly enhancing the network's performance. This upgrade allows for faster data transfer rates, which is crucial for supporting the increased number of connected devices and the need for high-speed internet for academic, research, and administrative activities.
